

Transportation Advisory Committee

Minutes January 16, 2014

The Transportation Advisory Committee met in regular session on January 16, 2014. Members present were Matt Jones, Eric Moore and George Sottilo. Also present was Ralph Messera, Public Works Director.

In the absence of the Chairman, Mr. Messera called the meeting to order at 7:05 PM. Mr. Moore moved that the election of officers for the coming year be deferred until the February meeting. Passed. Mr. Moore then moved that the minutes of the October 24, 2013 meeting be approved. Passed. (The committee did not meet in November and December).

Mr. Messera then gave the committee an up-date on the status of the following projects: S. Trade Street, Campus Ridge Relocation, Buckley Way, NC 51 and Mathews Mint Hill Rd. intersection, and NC 51 and Idlewild Roundabout. He also reviewed the DOT project ranking system that will start this month with projects nominations by the CRTPO.

Mr. Messera then advised the committee members of the coming meetings on the John Street Monroe Rd. widening on January 21 and the 51 and Matthews Mint Hill Rd. Intersection on January 29.

The Committee then discussed the CTP. Mr. Messera provided a summary of the recommendations for improvements on a number of the roads in the CTP. It was felt that the summaries were easier to understand than the maps in the document. The committee went through each one and confirmed the recommendation or in several cases made modified recommendations. Mr. Messera is to complete the summary sheets for the next meeting to allow the committee to complete the review and recommendations. It is the intent of the committee to have the CTP to the Board for approval in March.

There being no further business, the committee adjourned at 8:50 PM.
