


**AMENDMENT BY THE TOWN OF MATTHEWS TO SUBSECTION VI OF THE SECOND REVISED AND AMENDED JOINT PROCLAMATION OF THE CHAIRMAN OF THE MECKLENBURG COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, MAYOR OF THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE AND MAYORS OF THE TOWNS OF DAVIDSON, MATTHEWS, MINT HILL AND PINEVILLE, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE MECKLENBURG COUNTY PUBLIC HEALTH DIRECTOR IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE DIRECTOR OF THE OFFICE OF THE CHARLOTTE MECKLENBURG EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT DEPARTMENT, DATED JULY 23, 2020**

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor of Matthews has determined that section VI of the above-referenced second revised and amended joint proclamation shall be modified within the corporate limits of the Town of Matthews as follows:

vi. Restaurants, private clubs, bars and other food and beverage service businesses may allow sitting or standing at bars for food and beverage consumption, provided the required social distance is maintained, but shall not allow patrons to touch game equipment, such as pool tables, darts, pinball machines, or any other such game equipment that requires social touching of the game equipment; and

**WHEREAS**, all other provisions of the above-referenced second revised and amended joint proclamation remain in effect.
